

Hemingway-Boulders Wilderness

This area was designated as Wilderness on Friday, Aug. 7, 2015, following unanimous passage into law by Congress. Different than any other form of public land, Wilderness is established as an antidote to expanding settlement and growing mechanization, a place where ecosystems remain undeveloped and intact, natural processes unfold without intervention, and humans may visit but not stay. You can help protect these values for future generations.

- Take time to read this map and know if your planned trails are in or out of the wilderness.
- As with all wildernesses, this area is closed to bicycles, motor vehicles, wheeled carts, chainsaws and other motorized equipment.
- Existing regulations regarding group size, campfire prohibitions and stock use are still in effect.
